



james benning (b. 1942, milwaukee, us) has created an expansive body of work encompassing avant-garde film, painting, photography and installations. rising to prominence in the late 1970s for his work in film, benning developed a distinct visual language associated with extended real-time, single-shot frames and the use of landscape to convey deeper themes, which he continues to deploy to this day. exploring topics of marginalization of peoples, ecology and technology, benning often returns to grand narratives and their hidden undersides, inviting close examination of the lesser-observed and inviting reflection on the broader cultural consciousness.

selected solo exhibitions of his work include those at kunstverein in hamburg, hamburg (2015); kunsthaus graz, graz (2014); vox, centre de l'image contemporaine, montréal (2014); natural history museum, vienna (2014); and argos, centre for art and media, brussels (2012). notable group exhibitions include the whitney biennial, new york (1979, 1981, 1983, 1987, 2006, 2014); documenta 12, kassel (2007); and documenta 6, kassel (1977). screenings of james benning's films have been held at numerous institutions worldwide, including at film society of lincoln center, new york; whitney museum of american art, new york; Kunstmuseum basel, basel; museum of the moving image, new york; and arsenal – institut für film und videokunst, berlin. benning lives and works in val verde, california.

das umfangreiche werk von james benning (geb. 1942, milwaukee, us) umfasst avantgardefilm, malerei, fotografie und installation. in seinen filmischen arbeiten, mit denen er Ende der 1970er Jahre bekannt wurde, schuf er eine eigene, bis heute kontinuierlich weiterentwickelte bildsprache, die sich durch das Zusammenfallen von erzählzeit und erzähler Zeit in langen Einstellungen und Landschaftsaufnahmen mit Themen wie Marginalisierung, Ökologie und Technik auseinandersetzt. dabei gelangt Benning oft zu großen Narrativen und ihren verborgenen Seiten – eine Aufforderung, das vermeintlich Peripherie in den Blick zu nehmen und das kulturelle Bewusstsein zu erweitern.

Arbeiten von James Benning wurden in Einzelausstellungen internationaler Museen und Institutionen gezeigt, darunter Kunstverein in Hamburg, Hamburg (2015); Kunsthaus Graz, Graz (2014); Vox, Centre de l'Image Contemporaine, Montréal (2014); Naturhistorisches Museum Wien, Wien (2014), und Argos, Centrum voor Kunst en Media, Brüssel (2012). Darüber hinaus nahm der Künstler an bedeutenden Gruppenausstellungen teil, etwa an der Whitney Biennial in New York (1979, 1981, 1983, 1987, 2006, 2014) sowie der Documenta 12 (2007) und der Documenta 6 (1977) in Kassel. Vorführungen seiner Filme fanden in zahlreichen Institutionen statt, darunter Film Society of Lincoln Center, New York; Whitney Museum of American Art, New York; Kunstmuseum Basel, Basel; Museum of the Moving Image, New York, und Arsenal – Institut für Film und Videokunst, Berlin. Benning lebt und arbeitet in Val Verde, Kalifornien.
